Transcription of the Burial Registers of

United Methodist Church Warmley

Formerly known as Warmley Tower Ebenezer Methodist Church



This former Methodist chapel has two graveyards, one at the front and the other at the rear of the site. The front graveyard has been closed and is now a car park allowing for a change of use for the building. Some of the memorial stones have been moved to a lane at the side, which provides access to the rear. The rear one remains unchanged and is open only for burials in existing plots.

The first burial in the old burial ground at the front dates from 1860 and the register contains details of 579 burials. The rear, newer graveyard was opened in 1909 and its register lists 550 burials or internment of ashes. Each burial ground, has its own register but the transcription below lists them together in:

- 1. Date order
- 2. Surname order


In order to distinguish the separate register entries and graveyard plots, these numbers are suffixed by either 'F' or 'R' for front and rear graveyards.

However, a third register was kept from 1915 which duplicates most, but not all of the entries and details in the separate registers. This third register sometimes gives additional information and sometimes conflicting information, but where this occurs it has been noted in an additional column. Furthermore, there are five entries in this third register which are not listed in either of the other two.

Where the writing is unclear, especially for names, it has been cross-checked with the GRO death indexes in order to facilitate accurate transcription. Where no age was given in the registers this has been added in a separate column from the GRO index. For ages less than one year recorded as, for example 5 m (months), 5 w (weeks) or 5 d (days) the GRO age was checked and where present recorded in the GRO age column as 0, so statistical calculations could be performed on it.

My thanks go to Gwyneth Dean and Linda Pope for checking my transcription. Both have local knowledge of names and places and were invaluable in this regard. My thanks also go to Rev David Willis and Unity Oldland Methodist church council (where these registers were kept) for allowing this transcription.
